Frequently Asked Questions

Who orders Decipher Prostate?

Decipher Prostate must be ordered by your doctor or provider. No additional procedure is required.

How long does it take to get my Decipher Prostate test results?

Your Decipher Prostate test results will be provided to your doctor approximately 2-3 weeks after the date it was ordered.

Does Decipher Prostate test my DNA?

No, Decipher Prostate evaluates gene expression by measuring the tumor's RNA. This provides a glimpse of the tumor's activity or behavior.

What is tumor genomic testing?

Tumor genomic testing looks at genes, how they are interrelated, and their expression or activity within the cancerous tissue. This can help determine the behavior of the disease, such as its aggressiveness.

What information is used to determine my Decipher score?

Your Decipher score is derived from the expression of 22 genes from your prostate cancer tumor, and does not consider any other clinical information such as Gleason score or PSA level.





About Decipher Prostate

- It is a 22-gene genomic test that looks at the molecular characteristics of your tumor to assess its aggressiveness, or likelihood of spreading outside the prostate.
- The result is a number from 0-1 (your Decipher score), that is classified as Decipher Low Risk, Decipher Intermediate Risk or Decipher High Risk.
- Testing is performed on existing prostate tumor tissue from your biopsy or radical prostatectomy (surgery to remove the prostate).

No additional procedure is required.



Why Did My Doctor Order Decipher Prostate?

Before you & your doctor decide how to manage your prostate cancer, your doctor will assess your **risk level** by considering all available information about your tumor, including your:


- » Gleason score,
- » Prostate specific antigen (PSA) level &
- » Clinical stage.

Based on these factors alone, it is not always clear <u>when</u> or <u>if</u> treatment is needed and, if so, <u>how much</u> treatment is necessary.




More information about the biology of your tumor (i.e., your Decipher score) can help determine the best management plan for you.
